

# 2009 Kansas International Dragway Points Race

## Schedule and rules and Payout

- 1) There are only 10 races in the KID Points racing series. You will be allowed to drop one race.
- 2) Points will accumulate as follows, 100 points for entry(show up points, if car is broke and you still want “show up points” race tow vehicle in first round and dial appropriate index) you will still be required to buy tech card.
- 3) Every round win will net racer 50 points. This includes “Buy Backs”
- 4) Bonus Points for Winner and Runner up as follows, 50 extra points to Win! 25 to Runner Up.
- 5) In the event of a rainout, If we start running eliminations in any class all the cars that have bought a tech card prior to the race being called will earn “show up” points. Once the race has been “technically called” Points earning tech cards will not be sold.
- 6) In the event of a rainout during eliminations, (point’s races only) and prior to money rounds, all cars left in will get a rain check good for next point’s race entry. If the class has entered the “paying rounds” The Purse will be split among the contestants left in the race, and all the contestants left in will receive 10 bonus points. If a race is in eliminations there will be no spectator rain checks.
- 7) The race dates are all Saturday evenings. Points Race #1, April 11, Points Race #2, April 18, Points Race #3 is May 16, Points Race #4 is June 13, Points Race #5 is July 11<sup>th</sup>, Points Race #6 is July 18<sup>th</sup>, Points Race #7 is August 22, Points Race #8 is September 12, Points Race #9 is September 26, and Points Race #10 will be October 24.
- 8) You must be entered in the points, and be an NHRA member with ET number to run for KID at the Division 5 ET Finals September 18 -20.
- 9) The top Points earners for (Super/Pro, Top Eliminator), Pro, Sportsman, and Pro Bike. At the end of the September 12, point’s race will represent KID in the Race of Champions at Heartland Park Topeka during the Division 5 ET Finals. There will be a “run off” between Top Eliminator and Super/Pro on the ¼ mile to determine who will get to represent the track between those two classes Only
- 10) High school class will be determined by the 4 top point’s earners in point’s series prior to the ET Finals.
- 11) Special KID shirts will be awarded to all 40 Qualifiers and the 4 High school participants attending the ET Finals @ Heartland Park Topeka. Special KID shirts will also be given to all of our Junior Dragster Participants at the Junior Nationals @ Denver in July.
- 12) Cost to enter points is (\$50.00 Super Pro and Top Eliminator), (\$40.00 for Pro), (\$30.00 for Sportsman) and (\$25 for Junior Dragster)
- 13) Gold Cards, Plaques and Jackets will be awarded to all winners at the year end Banquet tentatively November 21, 2009. The points will pay a minimum of what a guaranteed purse is for our Points races, (with the exception of Pro Bike) Win, R/U, Semi’s will be 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.
- 14) You must pay for points by 4-18 or you accumulated points will be lost.
- 15) You can not transfer your points to another class, and you can only earn points in one class per driver. However, you can earn points in one car with two different drivers in two different classes as long as you can make the call to the lanes. IE. A driver can run multiple classes in two different cars however we will only allow one entry per driver to the ET Finals.
